

Concession Stand Info For Teens

If you can't make your shift, call/email me immediately (remember school work comes first). Call me at 703.550.2295 or 703-882-1636. Email prklein1@juno.com. Parents, if you need to reach your child while they are working, the number in the stand is 703.971.3424. Teens will be able to use this phone to call their ride.

You will be paid \$20.00 per shift. It is important that you arrive on time and stay for the entire shift.

You are allowed a hot dog and fries at the end of the shift. You may drink fountain drinks during your shift, but please keep them on the far counter to avoid spills. Please do not eat while you are working at the window.

If you want to buy something in the stand, please give the money to an adult to make the purchase.

First thing you do when you enter the stand: Wash your hands. Wash them every time you leave the stand, blow your nose, etc.

Drink tickets are only sold to adults. They are \$0.75. There is a chart over the French fry warmer and near the cups to show the price. Please don't sell more than 26 tickets to a person.

DRINK TICKETS ARE ONLY GOOD FOR MEDIUM FOUNTAIN DRINKS!!

Keep your work area clean during the shift. It makes clean up easier at the end of the shift.

When you get low on: French Fries (only 2 left), Hot Dogs (only 5 left), quarters (only 8 left), let the adults in the back know so we can get more.

Periodically check the: plastic ware, napkins, cups and condiments to make sure they are not empty.

When you take an order for:

Chicken fingers- ask if they want ranch, BBQ or honey mustard sauce.

Mozzarella Sticks-ask if they want marinara sauce

Burgers- ask if they want lettuce, tomato, onion or mayo
(you can write this as "l, t, o or m).

Remember to remove the number tab at the bottom and give it to the customer.

Place order sheets on the hanger near the grill from left to right, and let the adults know what the order is for.

It is not necessary to write down drinks, hot dogs, candy, fries, nachos or other items served from the front of the stand. But if it is easier for you to keep track of a large order, it is fine.

It takes about 7 minutes to make an order of chicken fingers, 3-4 minutes to make mozzarella sticks and 5 minutes to make a batch of fries.

Popcorn is on the shelves near the door and under the microwave. It goes in the microwave for 1 min 40 seconds.

Once the weather gets hot, the chocolate candy will either be in the refrigerator in the back or in one of the drink refrigerators.
